Technical tips:



- Find a well-lit area. If you are filming a video, ensure your environment does not have any background noises.
- If possible, avoid strong light sources behind you. Try to position your face so it is facing <u>towards</u> a light source, such as a window or light fixture.
- Set your camera or phone in portrait mode (vertically)
- You can hold the phone in your hand or place it at eye level, ensuring you are clearly visible in the frame.
- If for any reason you prefer to remain anonymous, you don't need to show your face and can submit a fictional name. In that case, you can perhaps submit a photo or video of your feet walking, scenery in your city, or the back of yourself.

Important:

If you are helping someone else to share their story, please ensure they are aware of the purpose of Earth4All, that they provide free and informed consent, and they find it safe and useful (for them) that their story is told and amplified on our social channels. Also, allow them to use their own words and expressions, so that it is their true voice that is heard. By submitting a video, photo, or story you agree Earth4All may use distribute the video recording or materials on the Earth4All website or social media channels.
